All roping events will be 2 go-rounds with short-go. There will not be any two-headers. 4D barrel jackpot is 2 go-rounds with average pay-off, plus 2022 year-end top ten in 40s, 50s, 60s and 70s run in short-go. Positions will be drawn in the short-go barrels.
