Other Information

All rodeos must be entered on the Tuesday evening prior to the rodeo. Books are open from 6-9 pm.

979-777-3527. **LATE ENTRIES TAKEN ON WEDNESDAY FROM 6:00 to 9:00 CALL IN ONLY WITH \$25.00 LATE FEE.** There is always a sign-up sheet at each rodeo for the next rodeo and you may enter by signing up.

All contestants must wear long sleeve shirts with collars and hats when competing.
(Ribbon runners do not have to wear hats).

DRAW OUT RULE

Draw-out time for a contestant is 24-hours prior to rodeo. If a contestant does not draw-out 24-hours prior to rodeo, his/her stock will be drawn. The contestant will be fined the \$25 office charge plus \$25 per event/per horse/per entry. The first time a contestant fails to draw-out, he/she will be allowed to enter the next rodeo and pay the fine at the rodeo. After the first offense, all fines will be paid before a contestant may enter another rodeo. An appeal may be filed within ten (10) working days of the infraction.

ENTRY FEES: Entry Fees must be paid on Saturday before a contestant rides/ropes. Barrel racers must be paid by noon on day competing. If entry fees are not paid a fine of \$50.00 will be assessed for the first offense and \$100.00 for the second offense.

TEAM ROPERS

40+ Lady Team Ropers may compete up in the 60+ age group but not up into the 70+ age group. Cattle will be chute run in the team roping. Team Roping will immediately follow the calf roping on Saturday and after the barrels on Sunday. **Incentive header #5:** Any header classified as a 5 or under will be an incentive with anyone he/she ropes with. **Incentive heeler #6:** Any heeler classified as a 6 or under will be an incentive with anyone he/she ropes with.

CALF ROPING

Drag rule (Page 35 #5) will be in effect at all rodeos. The intentional abuse of cattle/livestock by a contestant, as rendered by the judge, will be assessed a \$75.00 fine.

Team Roping: An electric eye barrier will be used for all Team Roping age groups.

2024 Entry Fees increased: 40's to \$150.00 per day, 60's to \$180.00 per day and 70's to \$150.00 per day.

40-59 AGE GROUP: Enter 1 draw 1 for \$150.00 or enter open and draw 2 with Incentive header #5 (any header classified as a 5 or under will be an incentive with anyone he/she ropes with). Incentive heeler #6 (any heeler classified as a 6 or under will be an incentive with anyone he /she ropes with). May Enter twice. All headers entered open will first be paired with another heeler entered open. Incentive teams will rope for 75% of their fees (after deductions). Incentive teams are eligible for both pots.

60 + AGE GROUP: Enter 1 draw 2 for \$180.00 or enter open and draw 3. All headers entered open will first be paired with another heeler entered open.

70 + AGE GROUP: Enter 1 draw 2 for \$150.00 or enter open and draw 3. All headers entered open will first be paired with another heeler entered open.

Order of Events: Barrels; Breakaway 70, 80; Ladies Breakaway 1st go; 70, 80; Ladies Breakaway 2nd go; 50, 60,40 Breakaway; Ribbon Roping; Tiedown 75, 70, 65, 50, 60, 40; Team Roping except on Sunday when Team Roping will be after Barrels.

Miscellaneous info :

Rodeo Secretary:

As of July 1, Connie Clute has taken the Rodeo Secretary position. She will be handling all the entries on Tuesdays. The new entry number will be (979) 777-3527. She and Debbie will be handling all the office duties at the rodeos. With the change, Connie and Deb will be conducting a mid-season audit on points in all events to verify that all point counts are correct to this point of the year and to help alleviate some of the year end time crunch. The Board is excited that Connie has taken on this task, she was our first choice last November, but had other obligations that prevented her from taking the position at that time. We feel very fortunate that she is able to take this on.
