Other Information

All rodeos must be entered on the Monday evening prior to the rodeo. Books are open from 6-9 pm.
254-223-2290 NO LATE ENTRIES TAKEN. There is always a sign-up sheet at each rodeo for the next rodeo and you may enter by signing up.

All contestants must wear long sleeve shirts with collars and hats when competing.
(Ribbon runners do not have to wear hats).

DRAW OUT RULE

Draw-out time for a contestant is 48-hours prior to rodeo. If a contestant does not draw-out 48-hours prior to rodeo, his/her stock will be drawn. The contestant will be fined the \$25 office charge plus \$25 per event/per horse/per entry. The first time a contestant fails to draw-out, he/she will be allowed to enter the next rodeo and pay the fine at the rodeo. After the first offense, all fines will be paid before a contestant may enter another rodeo. An appeal may be filed within ten (10) working days of the infraction.

TEAM ROPERS

Team Ropers (40-59 and 60+) you may enter with a partner and draw 2 or you may enter open and draw 3 partners; 40-59 \$125/per contestant, 60 over \$110/per contestant. Team Ropers 70+ \$75/per contestant: enter one – draw one or enter open and draw 2. 60-69 Team Ropers will be permitted to enter both sides “head and heel: on the same day at all rodeos. 40+ Lady Team Ropers may compete up in the 60+ age group but not up into the 70+ age group. Cattle will be chute run in the team roping. Team Roping will not start before 4:00pm and the teams must be confirmed to the Rodeo Secretary by 1:30pm – NO EXCEPTIONS

CALF ROPING

Drag rule (Page 32 #5) will be in effect at all rodeos. The intentional abuse of cattle/livestock by a contestant, as rendered by the judge, will be assessed a \$75.00 fine.

TSPRA MEMBERS:

The 2022 Rodeo season is approaching fast. We are excited to see you all at the first Rodeo on March 12th & 13th in Hamilton. Buckles will be awarded in each event for the average of both days. You must enter both days to compete for the average.

MEMBERSHIP – Make sure to get your Membership in early to avoid the line at the first Rodeo. **A paid Membership by March 1st will get you in a drawing for \$100.00 cash.**

CHANGES – Please be aware of a few changes, listed below, made by the Officers and Directors in response to your suggestions.

40; 50; 60; 65 Tiedown – Two Header: Two Headers will be ***twice a year*** instead of three times per year. (See schedule on front page)

70 Tiedown: One head event at all scheduled TSPRA rodeos.

70-79 Breakaway –Two head event at all scheduled TSPRA rodeos.

40-59 Team Roping: Entry fee raised by \$15.00 to \$125.00 per contestant per rodeo.

60 + Ribbon Roping: Added a 60 and over Ribbon Roping **SERIES** at all 2022 scheduled TSPRA rodeos. Points will be awarded to both runner and roper; and where a 60 + roper and runner team could also enter down in the 40-59 age group and receive points; and where a 60 and over runner could enter down with a 40-59 age roper and points awarded; and where a 60 and over roper could enter down with a 40-59 age runner and points awarded. *****All Ribbon Roping Rules (Page 36-38) will apply for the 60 and over Ribbon Roping Series.***

2022 TSPRA Rule Changes:

TIEDOWN ROPING: Page 31 – #4: If calf is down when roper reaches it, the roper must daylight and flank the calf except in the 70 and over tiedown events.

Page 31 - #4: In the 70 tiedown event, the Field Judge will pass on the tie when roper remounts the rope horse and ridden forward one step.

Page 31 - #4: The Field Judge will pass on the tie of calf through use of a stop watch, timing six seconds from the time the rope horse takes first step forward after the roper has remounted, with exception of 75 and over the stop watch will start when roper clears the calf.

Page 34 - #14: A 25 second time limit will be enforced in 40; 50; 60; 65 tie down events.

Page 34 - #15: A 30 second time limit will be enforced in 70 and 75 tie down events.

Breakaway: Page 33 – #11: Ladies Breakaway: Catch must be a bell collar catch

Team Roping Rules: Page 34 – Add New #2 (renumbered 2-16): 60-69 Team Ropers will be permitted to enter both sides “head and heel: on the same day at all rodeos.

Finals: Page 39 – ADD #5 c: A member/contestant must enter an event(s) 5 times during the year in order to enter that event(s) at the Finals

Gifts: Page 13 – These gifts are encouraged and will be submitted through the TSPRA General Account.
